This workshop is designed for parks maintenance staff, public works staff, landscapers, and contractors working on individual lots or small sites. It will provide participants with information on how to keep the dirt in place or capture it before it reaches lakes, streams and wetlands directly or through the stormsewer system. For those involved in soil disturbing activities such as excavating or grading, or that encounter erosion problems as part of their work, this workshop will provide information and examples of solutions and products for preventing erosion, capturing sediment and for repairing small erosion problems. We will discuss what products and materials to use where and when, proper installation techniques, good seed bed preparation for vegetation growth and approximate costs for various types of products.

In addition to presentations, participants will have an opportunity to look at photos of several sites and work together to identify & discuss erosion and sediment control solutions.

Product suppliers will be on hand with samples of various types of products to help you control erosion, capture sediment, and establish vegetation.

Note: This workshop is not designed for projects disturbing one acre or more that require an NPDES/SDS Stormwater Construction Permit.
